

BOOK YOUR CRUISE ABOARD OASIS OF THE SEAS

Royal Caribbean's Oasis of the Seas is currently on its twelve-day maiden voyage from Finland, where the massive ship was constructed at the STX Finland Oy shipyard, to Miami, Florida. Miami and Ft. Lauderdale are popular ports of departure for cruise vacations.

Measuring 1,200 feet from bow to stern, with 16 decks and a capacity for 6,300 passengers, the Oasis of the Seas is the largest cruise ship the world has ever seen.

As expected from the cruise line that first introduced rock-climbing walls and surf simulators at sea, Oasis of the Seas raises the bar for elaborate onboard features, and boasts a park with live trees, a zip line above an open-air atrium, a handcrafted carousel, and its innovative, "neighborhood" concept, which organizes its onboard features into seven distinct areas.
