

## Last Minute Holiday And New Year Cruise Deals With Royal Caribbean

Royal Caribbean has last-minute deals for holiday and New Year's cruises aboard Oasis of the Seas. Travelers can book these right now through Liberty Travel.

Measuring 1,200 feet from bow to stern, with 16 decks and a capacity for 6,300 passengers, the Oasis of the Seas was until recently the largest cruise ship in the world—its fellow Oasis-class ship, *Allure of the Seas* is actually bigger, albeit only by two inches.

As expected from the cruise line that first introduced rock-climbing walls and surf simulators at sea, *Oasis of the Seas* offers a list of elaborate onboard features, including a park with live trees, a zip line above an open-air atrium, a handcrafted carousel, and its innovative, "neighborhood" concept, which organizes its onboard features into seven distinct areas.

Cruisers now have the opportunity to enjoy these features and many more during two cruises sailing out of Ft. Lauderdale within the next two weeks.

The first leaves port on December 23, and is a seven-day Caribbean cruise with scheduled stops in Labadee, Haiti, and two ports of call in Mexico, Cozumel and Costa Maya. Prices start at \$1,199<sup>†\*</sup> per person.

Then, on December 30th there is a 9-night Caribbean cruise. This one also stops in Labadee, before sailing on to St. Thomas, St. Maarten and the Bahamas. Prices start at \$1,399<sup>†\*</sup>
